A38 Goodstone to Kenn – 10 January to 10 March 2022 Overnight works – Monday to Friday 8pm to 6am

National Highways operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A roads.

We'll be resurfacing in both directions between Goodstone and Drumbridges. We'll also carry out drainage works between Chudleigh and Chudleigh Knighton and tree removal work will take place between Splatford Split and Drumbridges. We'll work overnight Monday to Friday to minimise disruption to daytime traffic. During the day the road will be open as usual but please allow extra time for your journey if travelling overnight.

Please accept our apologies in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. We'll make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to a minimum.

- Westbound – the carriageway will remain open with a section of A38 convoy working, the A38 Goodstone westbound entry slip will be closed.

10 March

- Eastbound – the A38 will be closed between Goodstone and Chudleigh Station.
- Westbound – the A38 will be closed between Splatford Split and Goodstone.
