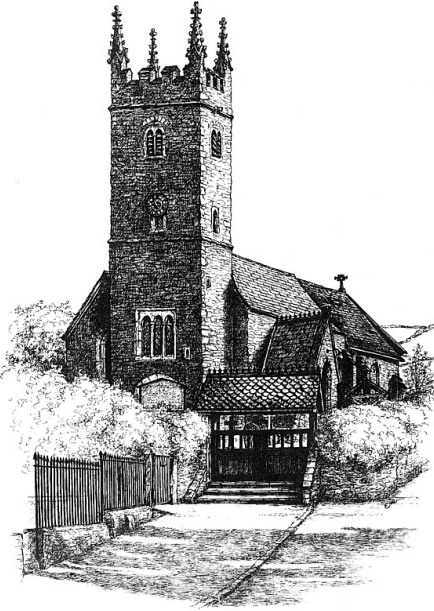

Revd Jane writes:

Christmas hasn't been cancelled – but it will look different this year.

What, no Crib Service or Christingle?

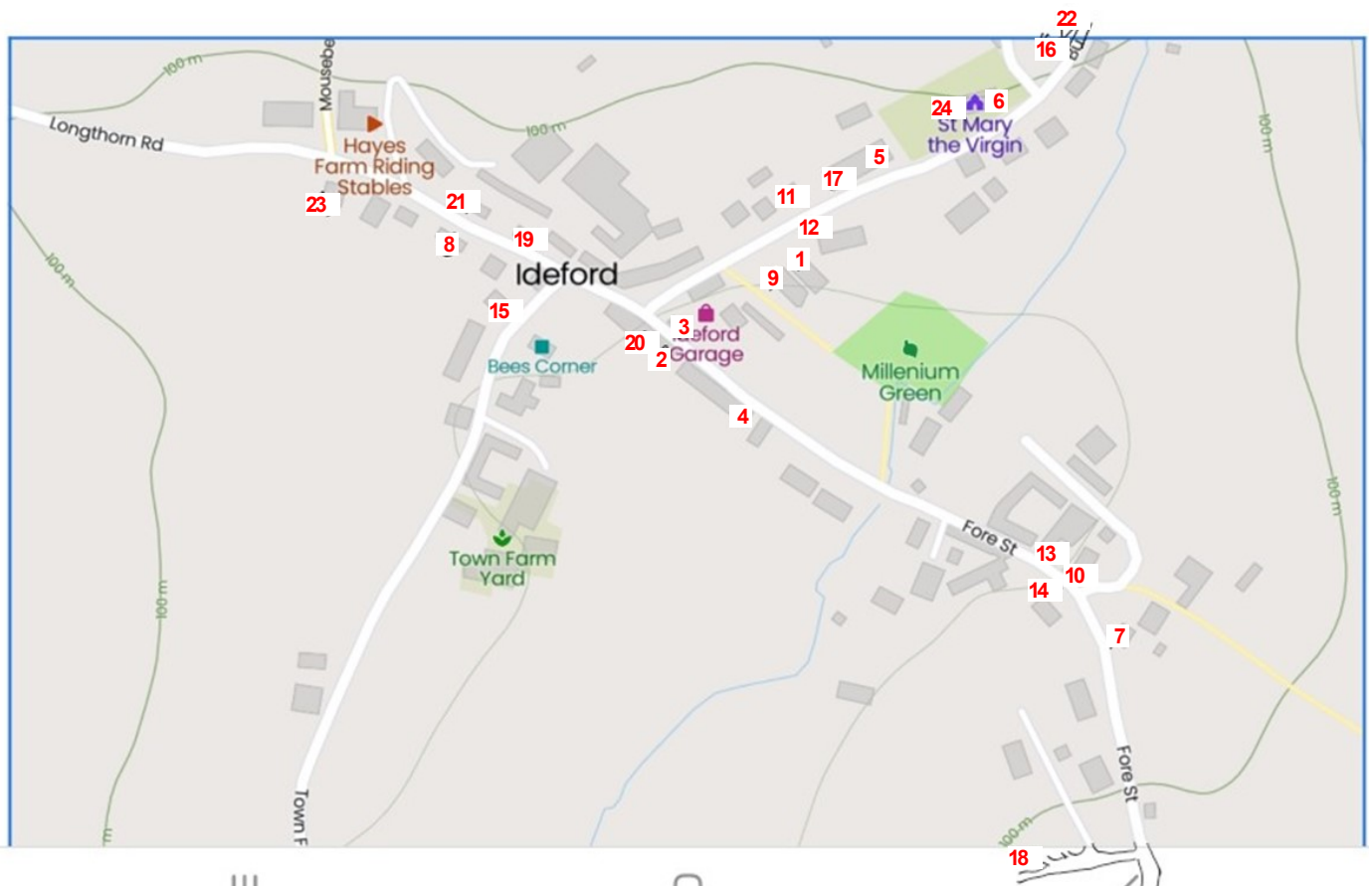

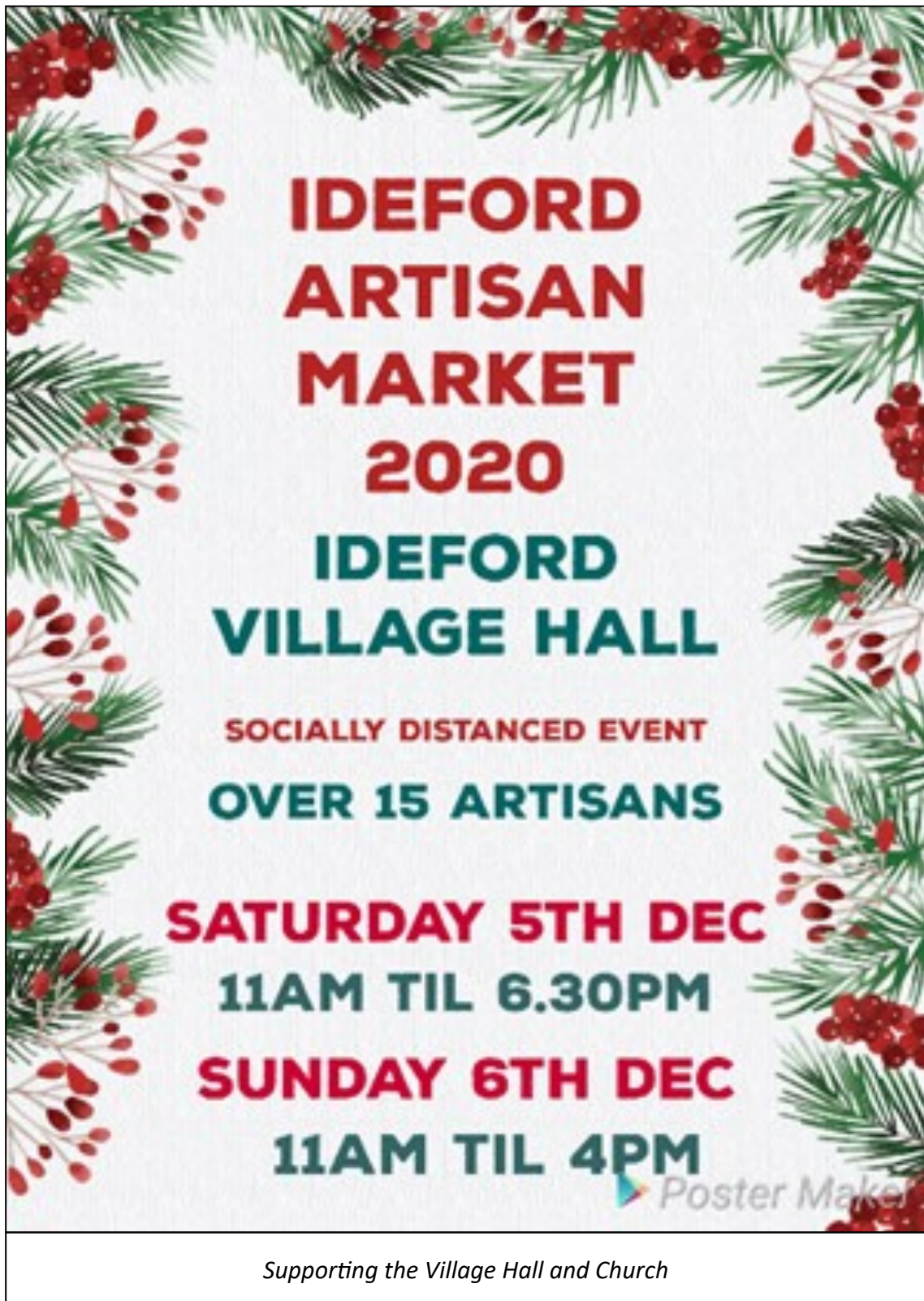
