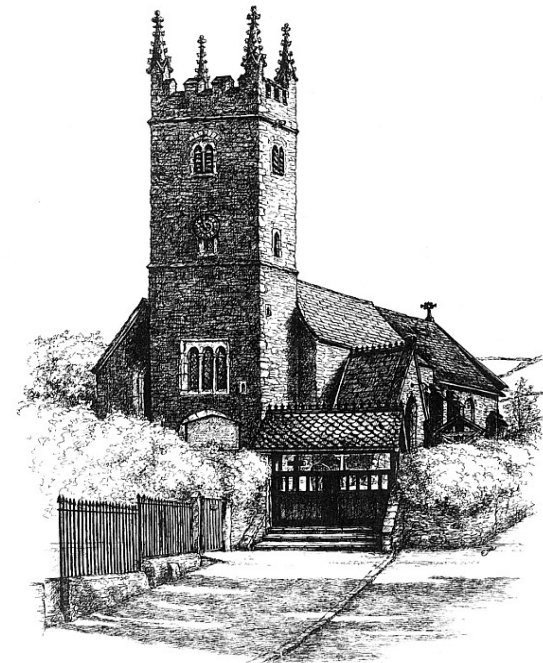

Father Mark Skelton reflects..

At present there is so much that is no doubt crowding our prayer time that we may sometimes lose sight of the fact that part of what prayer is about is enabling the Lord to enter in and reassure and encourage. We can look at the situations in Ukraine, Afghanistan, the Yemen and so many other places and feel powerless, angry, helpless and maybe guilty so we are unable to listen out for that still, small voice and yet, if we are to be people of true Christian witness it is important that we remember that we are not doing it by ourselves or at least, we are not supposed to. The Body of Christ is a real strength and support when we feel lost or unable to see our way forward clearly. The great prayer cried to God; "I can't, You must" can also apply to those around us. Sometimes I am the person who needs the support of another and sometimes, though I may not see it, I am the support.

Pentecost is the wonderful moment of realization on the part of the early Church when 'the penny dropped' and they recognized the way in which Christ wanted to work through them. The power and flame, the wind and light energized and transformed those scared men and women and drove them out to proclaim the hope of the Gospel. However, I am always struck by the wonder of Easter that, although it took the 'oomph' of the Holy Spirit's descent into that upper room to make the Apostles realize their full potential, Christ had already given the Holy Spirit to them on the Day of Resurrection when He breathed gently and unassumingly into them and said 'Receive the Holy Spirit'.

There is great power and strength and wonder in the Church and in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our lives but sometimes that can be gentle and quiet and even unnoticed. Let's recapture that wonderful realization that God does not always work in mighty noise and power and clear sight, sometimes indeed oftentimes, He is waiting nearby, ready to give us what we need so that we can share it with others.

Teignbridge District Council would like to remind 'green bin subscribers' that only organic waste such as grass cuttings, leaves, flowers, twigs, weeds, hedge trimmings and plant clippings should be placed in the garden waste bins.

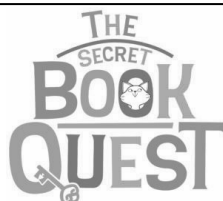


Garden waste collected at the kerbside is taken to a composting site where it is turned into a nutritious soil conditioner which increases the nutrients and improves a soils structure to help plants grow. This can then be used for agriculture, land reclamation and as an ingredient in some multipurpose composts you can buy at a garden centre.

If you use the garden waste collection service, please use your garden waste bin for garden waste only.

If your children or grandchildren enjoy reading, they might enjoy 'The Secret Book Quest' being run by Devon Libraries.

In case of defibrillator activation it is necessary for the Ambulance Service to report such instances, make contact with the local caretaker, and ensure that equipment is made fully operational after use.

If delivery details have been passed to a supplier, or courier company they will be required to delete your data after delivery unless needed for repeat deliveries.

You have a right to request viewing any information that we hold on you.

All data will be held for historical purposes for a minimum of 20 years. CHT is registered with the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) for holding of this information. Data held by CHT will not be passed to any 3rd party marketing organisation.
