

October reflections from Revd Jane

Sometimes it's good to see the bigger picture isn't it?.... particularly at times when circumstance seems overwhelming and particular points of view - our own internal voice or the opinions of other - have skewed the lens we look through at the world.

I don't know what you do or where you turn to re-store your perspective. I tend to light a candle...to stand on the sea wall in Teignmouth...to walk down with Daisy, our dog, to Flow Point or Bishop Beach to take stock in the presence of the Teign. Sometimes being with others where ongoing personal stories are shared can also be helpful, particularly if I'm really attending & being present with what is voiced rather than succumbing to distraction.

The Autumnal month of October can be a bigger picture restorer. There's a choice of focus isn't there? Heavy dews, fading light, waning vegetation and falling leaves can speak of time moving on...of decay and loss. However, Harvest speaks of abundant fruitfulness and the potential for future flourishing through seed production. The seasonal colour palate is rich and heart-lifting. Sunshine is highly-prized. Information about the marking of Harvest 2021 is given elsewhere in the Parish News.

An October evening is a good time to stretch out one's hand for a good read. Malcolm Guite's relatively recent poetry collection 'David's Crown', his 21st century response to the Psalms nestles among the novels and gardening books in my pending pile. Here's an extract I found to be timely. May it be so for you:

...Then let the chaff of life just blow away
The cynic scoffer and the evil troll,
The hunters and the haters who hold sway
In raging twitter storms, the ones who scroll
Through hate- and hit-lists in their tiny rage,
Are dust upon the mirror of your soul...

...Let him look after you
And in the morning when you rise again
Then let him lift your head and change your view
Replenish, renovate you, and sustain
His long slow blessings in your growing soul,
Till troubles cease and only joys remain.

IDEFORD PARISH COUNCIL HAS A VACANCY FOR A PARISH COUNCILLOR.

The Parish Council invite eligible parishioners to contact the Clerk expressing their interest. Interviews will be held in October with a plan to co-opt at the Thursday 14th October 2021 meeting.

WHY SHOULD I BECOME A COUNCILLOR?

Do you care about your community?

Do you believe in strong representation?

Do you want to become involved in shaping the future of your community and the wider Parish?

AMONG other Parishes, Teignbridge and Devon County we have forged good communications and are known for our determination, fairness, transparency and over-riding politeness when dealing with a variety of issues. It has taken years of building relationships to achieve our present status.

EXPECTATIONS

- To attend Parish Council on the second Thursday of each month, except January and August, when there are no meetings, unless an issue arises that needs prompt attention e.g. planning.
- To represent Parishioners who may have an issue that the Council can give advice on or help with.
- To gain a wider knowledge of your Parish.
- To take a full part in all discussions.

YOU CAN......be co-opted onto the Council at the present time with no need for an election. How much time you spend on your duties is largely up to you. As with most things in life, what you get back will depend on how much you put in.

ELIGIBILITY Any person wishing to be considered to act as a Parish Councillor must be qualified to hold office. Sections 79-81 of the Local Government Act 1972 contain the relevant provisions regarding the qualification of candidates, as follows:

To qualify as a candidate and to continue to hold the office of Parish Councillor a person must be a British or Commonwealth citizen, citizen of the Republic of Ireland or a citizen of another Member State of the European Union and, on the relevant day, must have attained the age of eighteen years.

In addition, the candidate must qualify under at least one of the following conditions:

- on that day and thereafter s/he continues to be registered as a local government elector for the parish (meaning the whole area of the parish);
- during the whole of the 12 months preceding s/he has occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the parish;
- during the 12 months preceding their principal or only place of work has been in the parish; or
- during the whole of the 12 months preceding s/he has been resident in the parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it (of its parish boundary).


On Saturday 13th November
